A notice to submit a planning application for the proposed Lissinagroagh Wind Farm is being placed in the Leitrim Observer and the Irish Independent this week. You will also see planning notices being erected and displayed around the proposed site for this FuturEnergy Ireland project. The application is expected to be submitted by FuturEnergy Lissinagroagh DAC to An Coimisiún Pleanála shortly.

When all documentation has been received and validated by An Coimisiún Pleanála, the full wind farm application will be available to view at www.lissinagroaghplanning.ie.

The planning documents will also be available on An Coimisiún Pleanála's website www.pleanala.ie. Furthermore the planning application and Environmental Impact Assessment Report will be available for viewing at the offices of An Coimisiún Pleanála and Leitrim County Council.

A separate planning application for the grid connection associated with the project will be submitted to An Coimisiún Pleanála in the coming weeks and a copy of the application documents will be available at www.lissinagroaghgridplanning.ie.

There is a useful FAQ section on An Coimisiún Pleanála's website that provides guidance on public participation. Any person or body may make observations on the project to An Coimisiún Pleanála after the application has been submitted
